Set Up and Tear-Down Rules:

- Insurance has been provided to the fairgrounds by TSRS. If you require additional insurance, TSRS can offer suggestions as to who you can get that through.
- All booths must be paid in full at the time of registration.
- TSRS reserves the right to relocate any vendor at any time.
- Vendors MUST show sign of occupancy in their booth(s) by 8:30am on September 8th, 2023, or the booth(s) will be considered abandoned and the Exhibitor(s) therefore forfeits their booth(s) and all monies paid.
- Exhibitor(s) must be completely set up, in place, and organized NO LATER than 8:30am on September 8th, 2023.
- Exhibitors are REQUIRED to park in the parking lot on the "Carnival" side of the Commercial Building (see map).
- No exhibits may be dismantled and/or removed prior to 3pm on Friday, September 8th, 2023. In the event that an exhibitor begins to dismantle their booth(s) early or does not have their booth(s) completely cleaned and cleared by the designated time, a penalty of \$150.00 will be charged. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- All payments are non-refundable.

Display and Noise Rules

Every Exhibitor shall construct their booth in such a manner as not to interfere with neighboring displays. During the Show, exhibit noise levels shall be kept at a minimum, so as not to interfere with other Exhibitors. Every Exhibitor acknowledges and agrees that they are responsible for insuring that all Exhibitors have equal access to the public for the purpose of promoting their product. Further restrictions may be imposed in the sole discretion of TSRS.

Your Booth Space Includes:

- An exhibit space, 8' high backdrop, 3' side rails, (1) 8' table, 2 chairs. (Exhibitor needs to provide their own tablecloths and display materials.)
 - (NOTE: Reduced-price spaces, such as for non-profits, may not include the backdrops and side rails.)
- Access to the vendor snack room, which will have breakfast items (pastries, bagels, coffee) prior to 11am and snack items after 11am.
- Lunch will be provided.

No Assignment

Exhibitor shall not assign or sublease their space, or any part thereof, without the prior written approval of TSRS including, but not limited to, business cards, displays or any merchandise of a non-exhibitor.

Concessions

Food concessions must be approved by TSRS and the Josephine County Fairgrounds, and are subject to a fee of 17% of all sales paid to the fairgrounds. Alcohol consumption or sales not permitted at this event.

Vendor Information

At the entrance to both the Pavilion building and the Commercial building will be a TSRS table for vendor information, should you have questions about your booth.

Electricity

All booths will not be guaranteed access to electricity; if you need access to electricity, please make arrangements prior to August 11th, 2023, to let TSRS know you need to be placed near an electrical outlet. You are responsible for bringing extension cords and tape (cords MUST be taped down, or they cannot be used).

Wireless Internet Connection

There will be wifi available in both the Commercial Building and the Pavilion Building.




